Around the World

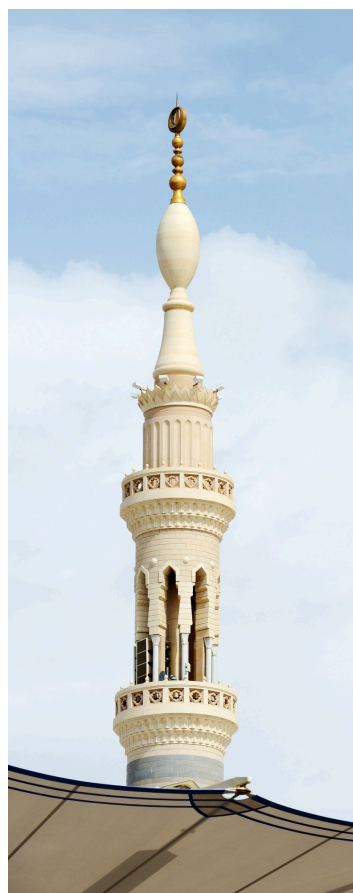
