THE DAY OF ASHURA

قال ﷺ
"وَصِيَامُ يَوْمِ عَاشُورَاءَ، إِنِّي أَخْتَسِبُ عَلَى اللَّهِ أَنْ يُكَفِّرَ السَّنَةَ الَّتِي قَبْلَهُ"
صحيح مسلم

Ashura, the 10th day of Muharram in the Islamic calendar, the day marks various historical events, including the deliverance of Prophet Musa (Moses) from Pharaoh's tyranny.

Fasting on Ashura is a sunnah, as Prophet Mohammad ﷺ highlighted its value where fasting this one day causes the forgiveness of our last year's sins. Moreover, fasting one day before or after is Mustahab (recommended). The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said: When the next year comes, God willing, we would observe fast on the 9th. But the Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) died before the advent of the next year.

As Muslims, we honor Ashura to contemplate the teachings of sacrifice, strength, and divine help shown by Prophet Musa and his followers.

As we observe Ashura, may Allah accept our prayers and grant us His blessings and forgiveness in this blessed month of Muharram.

The Story of Prophet Musa



A long time ago, in Egypt, there was a cruel king named Pharaoh. He made a harsh rule to kill baby boys born to Bani Israel every other year. One day, a loving mother had a baby boy named Musa. To protect him, she put him in a basket and set it afloat on the Nile River as guided by Allah. Allah commanded the river to be gentle. The basket floated to Pharaoh's palace, where his wife discovered Musa and decided to raise him as her son. Musa grew up in the palace but never forgot his people. With Allah's help, Musa led his people out of Egypt. When they reached the Red Sea, Musa raised his staff and Allah parted the waters, allowing them to cross safely. The sea then closed, keeping them safe from Pharaoh. Musa and his people were finally free.
