In our last newsletter, we explored dawah; now, we focus on the greatest example—Prophet Mohammad , whom Allah chose as the ultimate da'i. He was sent as a mercy to all mankind and made our guide in dawah.

After the passing of Abu Talib and Khadija, the Prophet went to Ta'if to call its people to Islam. The people of Ta'if rejected the message and threw rocks at him until he bled. As he was returning to Makkah, Allah sent the Angel of the Mountains to him, offering to crush the people between the mountains. The Prophet responded, "Rather, I hope that Allah will bring forth from their loins those who will worship Him alone and associate nothing with Him."

In the Battle of Hunain, the Muslims faced a strong and skilled army. The Prophet stood his ground when many of the Muslims have fled, he dismounted from his white she-camel and repeatedly said, "I am the Prophet; I do not lie. I am the son of Abdul Muttalib." His courage rallied the Muslims who had fled, and the battle ended in victory for the believers.

I was in my second year of medical school in Egypt when I went to college, as usual, to see many posters warning us that a very important visitor would be coming to visit soon. One of these posters stated that the visitor is the most important character in everyone's life. Many questions came to my mind trying to figure out who deserves the title of the "Most Important Person in My Life". Most students talked about this incident, but nobody knew the answer to this mystery.

Member Recognition


Inspiration
