TEN DAYS OF DHUL-HIJJAH

(والفجر *وليال عشر *والشفع والوتر)

The importance of the first 10 days

Allah has designated specific times and places for heightened worship and reward, notably the first ten days of Dhul-Hijjah. These days are so sacred that Allah swears by them in the Quran: "By the dawn; by the ten nights" [The Qur'an, 89:1-2]. The Prophet Mohammad emphasized their importance by stating: "No good deeds done on other days are superior to those done on these days." Even acts of jihad, unless involving extreme sacrifice, do not surpass the deeds done during these ten days.

Arafah and Eid-AlAdha

The first ten days of Dhul-Hijjah are considered superior to the last ten days of Ramadan, while the last ten nights of Ramadan are deemed superior to the ten nights of Dhul-Hijjah. The Day of Arafah, the ninth day of Dhul-Hijjah, is particularly significant, as the Prophet ﷺ said: "There is no day on which Allah sets free more slaves from Hell than He does on the Day of Arafah." We should all attempt to fast on this day to wipe away the sins of two years, the previous and preceding years as the prophet ﷺ mentioned. The subsequent Day of Sacrifice, is Eid al-Adha, where we will be sacrificing an animal for the sake of Allah, it's a day of joy and celebration, as it marks the end of those blessed 10 days.

How to benefit even more?

Engaging in additional prayers, charity, and remembrance of Allah are also highly meritorious acts during this period. As the Quran says, "That they may witness benefits for themselves and mention the name of Allah on known days over what He has provided for them of [sacrificial] animals. So eat of them and feed the miserable and poor." [The Noble Qur'an, 22:28].

In this issue, we are proud to recognize a valuable member who has made remarkable contributions to our community, Dr. Mountaha Yasin Kassab. An OBGYN physician by training, she practiced in Syria and Saudi Arabia before moving to Indiana with her family. Prioritizing her children's Islamic identity and Arabic-Quranic language, she dedicated herself to volunteering in Islamic schools and masjids since 1995.

Dr. Kassab has been an invaluable asset to the Alhuda Foundation since its establishment in 2002, serving as a curriculum planner and Arabic Quranic teacher. Her commitment extended to leading Quranic tafseer classes for 16 years and conducting Friday youth halaqas since 2009. MEMBERSHIP Senefits

Priority Booking: Members will receive priority in booking tickets for Masjid organized events (if applicable) such as Eid celebrations, Iftars during Ramadan, and interfaith dialogues, subject to seat availability and booking timelines.

Recognition Programs: This is for members who contribute significantly to the Masjid or community, through highlighting their efforts in newsletters or special events.
